

Top 5 Virtual Meeting Tools & Platforms

Uberconference:

Uberconference is a simple virtual conference line. You can join the conference via computer or phone. If you login by computer, you can share video, attachments, and screen share. It's quick to get signed up, logged in, and enhances productivity! This is a great tool for coalitions, nonprofits, and small organizations.

Google Hangouts:

Google Hangouts is another highly accessible, free platform where people can host meetings over the computer. Google is familiar to people who may not be as computer savvy. Recommended for use with teams who are not used to remote work.

Zoom Meetings:

Zoom is a sophisticated video conferencing platform which is ideal for team check-in meetings, presentations, or trainings. You must download the application to use Zoom.

Google Slides:

SurveyMonkey:
